We have one of those "good problems" in the Richmond Shag Club that on occasion presents an awkward situation for some of our instructors. Our

members, being the great shag ambassadors that they are, want to help with the dance lesson. In my own enthusiasm, I have been guilty of this myself, until I realize I am in an awkward place. More than once I have offered my apologies.

Many of our classes are large in number; it's not unusual to see 30 or 40 people attending. Believe me, if you haven't tried to control this many people, it isn't easy. You, as an instructor, must command their attention the entire time you have them on the floor. You are trying to teach a step your way, from your perspective. There are distractions; people are moving about, and as more dancers filter into Visions, the louder it gets. The instructors must wear a microphone to be heard, and even then it's sometimes difficult. That's all the more reason for the instructor to have the undivided attention of the class.

So, when you feel the urge to help, pause and think twice. Ask yourself if that is what you would want if *you* were teaching the class. After all, it is a little unsettling to be teaching and notice that some of your students have been pulled aside for a one on one. As good as your intentions may be; it's also confusing to the student.

During a dance class, there should be one message, and that delivered by the instructor.

So, as a courtesy, how about we all adopt a simple dance class etiquette rule of thumb: don't help with the lesson unless you have been invited by the instructor.



Joan Byrnes is recovering from back surgery. We wish Joan a speedy recovery and hope to see her back on the dance floor soon.


As always, our thoughts and prayers are with these folks/members as they recover from their losses, accidents and surgeries.
