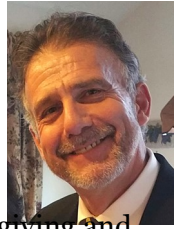

Upon their arrival, attendees were received by **Kevin** and **Joan Byrnes** and **Rogers** and **Nancy Verser**, directed to the coat room and their table and provided their 2 free drink tickets. A line quickly formed at the bar, but dissipated just as fast as the 2 MCC bartenders expertly filled orders, and members enjoyed the fruit, cheese and cracker appetizer table and mingled around the room, socializing and celebrating the season.

Pres. **Byrnes** also explained that the Board had approved a generous end-of-year bonus for Visions' bar managers **Tammy Reams** and **Jennifer Bondi** for their tireless service to the membership throughout the year.

Moving to the Camp Fantastic (CF) part of the program, Pres. Byrnes invited Special Love Executive Director **Dave Smith** and Camp parents **Stefanie** and **Paul Becker** to join him at the podium. Kevin recognized the team captains of the three primary fund-raisers (Golf Tournament: **Dickie Robinson** and **Doug Strother**; Silent Auction: **Nancy Wall** and **Mary Kathryn Taylor**; and SOS Charity Brunch hosts **Michael Feilding** and **Cleo Tinsley**) that contributed to the Club's annual contribution. **Dave Smith** expressed the Camp's appreciation for the Club's perennial support and clarified that the Richmond Shag Club's donation is the only sponsor-funding from the Richmond Metro area, directly supporting every Richmond area child that attends CF summer camp.

**Dave** introduced Camp parents **Stefanie** and **Paul Becker**, who explained that their son, Jack, was unable to attend due to a depressed immune system and Jack's siblings had stayed home to keep him company. Both **Stefanie** and **Paul** spoke eloquently of what attending camp means to the CF campers (and their families) and thanked the Club for its continued support. Pres. Byrnes then presented Dave with the Club's 2016 donation of **\$15,600**, noting that the accumulative Club donation to Camp Fantastic over 28 years now amounts to **\$270,346!**



Pres. Byrnes then recognized Dance Committee Chair **Joan Byrnes** to introduce and present the annual Most-Improved Shag Dancer Award winners, including:

- Best Female: **Sue McClendon**,
- Best Male: **Steve Bateson**, and
- Best Couple: **Roger & Denise Underhill**.

All recipients were surprised and very pleased to be recognized for their efforts.

**Kevin** then called on Vice President **Allen Batchelor** to introduce the incoming 2017 Board of Directors and asked Allen to explain the Club's Spirit of Shag (SOS) Award selection process. Allen presented the award to **Charles Harward, Sr.** for his devotion to the dance and helping so many members learn and enjoy the Shag.

**Kevin** proceeded to introduce the RSC honorary membership award, explaining that nominations sometimes come from the membership and other times come from the Board. In this case, the nomination (unanimously approved by the Board) came from a member who proposed that the Honorary Lifetime Membership Award should be given to **Joan Byrnes**, for her 11 years of service on the Board (including 2 as President), 10 (going on 11 in 2017) years as Annual Party chair, participation on and leadership of many Club committees, and the other awards she has received (e.g. Virginia Shaggers Hall of Fame, ACSC Shaggin' Icon, National Living Legends of Dance, etc.) which reflect well on the RSC. **Kevin** explained that it was a real challenge keeping this award secret at home, and presented **Joan** with an Honorary Membership plaque and permanent honorary membership card.

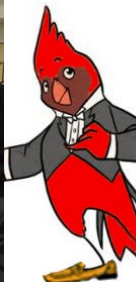
